- Access: No stairs or duck-unders using lower entrance (restroom on main floor would require climbing stairs.)

Prototype-freelanced railroad operating from Charleston, WV, to Roanoke and Danville, VA, featuring Norfolk Southern coal and freight traffic, plus run-through CSX coal traffic. The railroad is a double-deck point-to-point layout featuring approximately 225 feet of mainline and connecting branch lines. Single track with sidings. Medium traffic density.
