


## Neal Anderson's 'K K & L Railroad'




The KK & L Railroad is a local mixed freight and passenger railroad that supports operations of the Chicago Great Western and the Chicago and North Western Railroads. It is set in the Midwestern United States during the late 1950s - 1970s. This is a large layout on two levels, with more than 1,000 feet of track in a large basement. Parts of the layout are still under construction, but it is still a very exciting layout. One major feature of the layout is a 4-level, double track helix nicely disguised behind a large mountain. There are a variety of industries and passenger stations on the layout.

Ideal crew size is 12 - 14 operators. The railroad is Digitrax DCC. There are no duck-unders at this layout. No foreign power allowed for these sessions.
